- 1. <u>Suspended License</u> Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report proposing a modification of the language of N.J.S. 2C:40-26(b) to clarify that an individual who operates a motor vehicle beyond the determinate sentenced term of suspension, but before reinstatement, would properly be charged with N.J.S. 39:3-40 and not N.J.S. 2C:40-26(b). Report
- 2. <u>Partnership Trade Name Certificates</u> Consideration of a Draft Tentative Report proposing a modification to modernize the statutory provisions pertaining to partnerships, including penalties no longer consistent with the State's approach to business entity requirements. <u>Report</u>

- 6. <u>Inheritance from a Deceased Child</u> Consideration of a Memorandum proposing a potential project considering the circumstances under which a parent may be precluded from inheriting from a deceased child as discussed in *In re Estate of Fisher*, 443 N.J. - 7. <u>Theft of Immovable Property</u> Consideration of a Memorandum concerning the definition of the word "transfer" as used in N.J.S. 2C:20-3(b) based on the decision in *State v. Kosch*, 444 N.J. Super. 368 (App. Div. 2016). <u>Memo</u>
