## COMMISSION MEETING AGENDA

- 1. <u>Suspended License</u> Consideration of a Revised Draft Final Report recommending statutory modifications to clarify that an individuals who operate a motor vehicle beyond the determinate sentenced term of suspension, but before reinstatement of their driving privileges by the Motor Vehicle Commission, may properly be charged with N.J.S. 39:3-10 and not N.J.S. 2C:40-26(b).
